VOLUNTEER TO HELP FIT UNIFORMS: Uniform fittings are July 19th – 21st in the HS music room; seniors and Juniors on the 19th, sophomores on the 20th, and freshmen on the 21st. This is a major undertaking and requires many parents to help. The more help we have, the faster we can get the students through. 'BAND MOM' (DAD): We are looking for a mom or dad that can be with us from 10:30am – 5:00pm on certain days of our band camp. This 'band mom' will attend to a variety of requests from the directors. *The 'band mom' will be asked to bring popsicles for the entire band at their own expense.* This is an important snack that helps students replenish fluids and cool down so we can continue our field work.
